

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is Eligibility Test for UG Programmes?
Ans. The University will admit the students through eligibility test and to those who have not passed Intermediate or equivalent exam and seek to take admission into bachelor degree.
2. When will the notification come?
Ans. The notifications for all courses offered by the University are published in June-July months every year.
3. What courses are offered in your esteemed university?
Ans. PG Diplomas and Certificate courses, UG, PG, MBA, MBA (HCM), B.Ed., and M.Phil/PhD courses are offered in our University. For further details kindly visit the University website, www.braou.ac.in
4. How to Register for Admission?
Ans. You can register for admission through the online mode and download the University prospectus and fee details available in University portal www.braouonline.in and cash through AP/TS Online, Credit Card and Debit Card.
5. What are the eligibilities to study Bachelor Degree in your University?
Ans. You need to pass Intermediate or equivalent i.e. I.T.I. / Polytechnic for direct admissions or through ET and should have 18 years of age.
6. Can I change my Address and study centre?
Ans. Yes, you can change your address and study centre.
7. What is the procedure to take MBA Admission?
Ans. You need to pass any Bachelor Degree and also qualify the ICET conducted by Govt. of Telangana
8. What is the eligibility criterion for admission into MBA Health Care Management?
Ans. One should qualify Bachelor degree and should pass the Entrance Exam
9. Can I study PG in your university?
Ans. Yes, you need to pass Bachelor degree with relevant subject.
10. What is the procedure to study B.Ed. / B.Ed. in Special Education?
Ans. Bachelor degree and working experience at least 2 years.
11. How many hours of face-to-face Contact-cum-Counselling sessions are provided?
Ans. For UG: Optionals 12 hrs, each class 2 hrs
PG: 16 classes 1 and half hr
Languages: 4 classes, semester 8, 2 hours each class
Gender Sensitisation: 2 hrs (course type AECC)
Science and technology (GE): 2 classes, 4 hrs
B.Sc. Practicals: 30 hours in each subject/ each semester

12. Whether attending the Counselling sessions are mandatory?
Ans. No, but for practical courses 75% attendance is compulsory.
13. What is the role of Multimedia teaching learning in distance education?
Ans. Apart from the course material, multimedia teaching learning in distance education provides an interactive way for learners to gain knowledge about their subjects.
14. Does the university provide Multimedia teaching learning facilities?
Ans. Dr.BRAOU offers multimedia teaching learning through the medium of video lessons, T-SAT, Video Lessons, Radio lessons and Live Teleconferencing.
15. Does the university have Library facilities/ Book Learning Facilities?
Ans. Yes, the University offers library facilities to its learners.
16. Is there any student assessment system?
Ans. Yes, through the mediums of assignments, examinations
17. Can I have the option to choose a Study Centre, an Examination Centre?
Ans. You can choose Study Centre related to your specific subject. But, for appearing in your examinations, you will be assigned to the same Study Centre that you have previously selected.
18. Is there option for an online examination?
Ans. Presently, the University does not provide the facilities for online examinations
19. Are the courses offered by the Dr.BRAOU recognised by the UGC and other national and International bodies?
